Lodge

- Lodge hours are from 8 am to 10 pm. This includes the swimming pool and spa, bait, gas, game room, and bar. Dining hours are 8 am to 9 pm.
- Swimming suits are not allowed in the dining room and the movie room.
- Sports equipment available at the lodge includes: volleyball, horseshoes, canoes, sailboats, paddleboats, canyaks, football, softball. Please return equipment to original position.
- Laundry facility is open from 8 am to 9 pm and is located near the resort entrance for cottage guests, and on the 2nd floor of the lodge for those staying in lodge units. Change machine located in game room.
- Messages can be received at the reception desk.

Swimming Pool

- Floating toys/balls are not permitted in the swimming pool with the exception of those for children 0-5 years old.
- Food or beverages are not permitted in the swimming pool or spa.

Beach/Lake

- Paddle boats, canoes, kayaks, or boats of any kind are not allowed within 15 feet of the Rave.
- Dogs are **not allowed** in the Lodge or on the Beach. Dogs are not to be left unattended.
- State Law requires “Every Person” have a life preserver on while in any boat.

Dockhands

- Dock hand services are available from 8 am – 8 pm.
- Firewood is available for sale – **please make requests by 4:30 pm**.
 - Do not leave camp fires unattended. Douse before going in.

Cottages

- Please keep the grills and picnic tables off of the decks.
- Guests are responsible for damage to their cottage, furniture and equipment. Cottages left in extremely messy conditions that require extra cleaning time will result in additional charges. Please help us to keep our furnishings in good condition.
- When departing, please set out the garbage and have the dishes washed and placed in the cupboards.
- Group guests, please return any items shared from another cottage.
- *Thank you* for not lighting fire works on any day other than July 4th for the courtesy of other guests and young children.
